Temporary Closure of American River Bike Trail and Willow Creek

The Willow Creek unit of Folsom Lake SRA as well as the American River Bike Trail around Lake Natoma will be closed to all public use from 7:30 AM until 12:00 PM on Sunday, October 21, 2018, for the Folsom Breakout Blues Half Marathon.


This closure is for the protection of the public and event participants at Folsom Lake State Recreation Area.

This order will expire at 12:00 PM on October 21, 2018 at which time Willow Creek and the American River Bike Trail around Lake Natoma will reopen for public use.

Exceptions to this closure order include participants and event coordinators for the Breakout Blues Half Marathon.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Gold Fields District Superintendent at 7755 Folsom-Auburn Road, Folsom, CA 95630.

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
