
Temporary Vessel Speed Limit Reduction on Folsom Lake

Due to public safety concerns caused by low water levels, the vessel speed limit on Folsom Lake has been reduced to 5 miles per hour for the entire lake. With the low water levels, there are hazards throughout the lake that cannot be marked and create extremely hazardous conditions for vessel operation above 5 miles an hour. The speed limit will be rescinded once the lake level returns to a safe elevation.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Gold Fields District Superintendent at 7755 Folsom-Auburn Road, Folsom, CA. 95630

Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
