We are now accepting applications for the Beals Point and Peninsula Campground Camp Hosts for the summer of 2018. The time commitment is expected to be from April 1st thru October 1st, 2018 and requires a 30 hours per week work schedule.

The camp host duties consists of but not limited to:

- Updating the Rangers on the ever changing visitation and needs of the campground
- Registering new campers and providing basic information to visitor
- Basic campground maintenance and upkeep
- Staying on site during peak days and hours of visitation
- Conduct wood sales

Camp Hosts will have free hook up access during their volunteer service and be eligible to earn a State Parks Volunteer pass for 2018-2019. Additionally, letters of recommendation can be given for other camp hosts positions.

Peninsula campground is located off Rattlesnake Bar Road in El Dorado County, CA
