



Mammoth Bar OHV Area

is part of the Auburn State Recreation Area. It is located in the Sierra Nevada foothills about thirty miles northeast of Sacramento. This motorcycle/ATV riding area has been used by off road enthusiasts for over 30 years and offers a wide range of trails and conditions in a beautiful setting next to the Middle Fork of the American River. The area is operated by California State Parks on federal Bureau of Reclamation land. Some OHV motorcycle/ATV trails are open for two-way traffic and others are one way only. Vehicles are restricted to designated signed trails, to the MX tracks and *Observed Trials* area adjacent to the main parking area only.

Location

The entrance to Mammoth Bar is located on Old Foresthill Road. The easiest access is off of Interstate 80 north of Auburn. Take the Foresthill exit off I-80 and go east about 2.5 miles to the Old Foresthill Road. Turn right on Old Foresthill and the entrance is about 1.5 miles on the left.

Rules and Regulations

- Vehicles must have current, legal registration securely attached and clearly displayed.
- Red sticker vehicles are unrestricted year round.
- All off-highway vehicles must have a US Forest Service approved spark arrester in working condition.
- All off-highway vehicles must meet State noise standards (SAE J-1287 20" test, 96 decibel max).
- Vehicle use is limited to designated trails, the MX Tacks and Observed Trials hillside **only**. Causing resource damage by riding off trail carries heavy fines.
- ATVs are restricted from designated one-way trails.
- Vehicles over 50" wide are restricted from all areas.
- Operators of ATVs must wear a helmet and may not carry passengers.
- Operators of ATVs under 18 must have **ASI** safety certificate; under 14 must be supervised by certified adult. (www.atvsafety.org/)
- No camping, overnight parking or ground fires are allowed.

It is the rider's responsibility to know and comply with all applicable rules and regulations.

PLEASE NOTE:

Facilities include picnic tables, BBQ's, Chemical toilets. No drinking water is available.

Sun. Mon. Thurs. ONLY

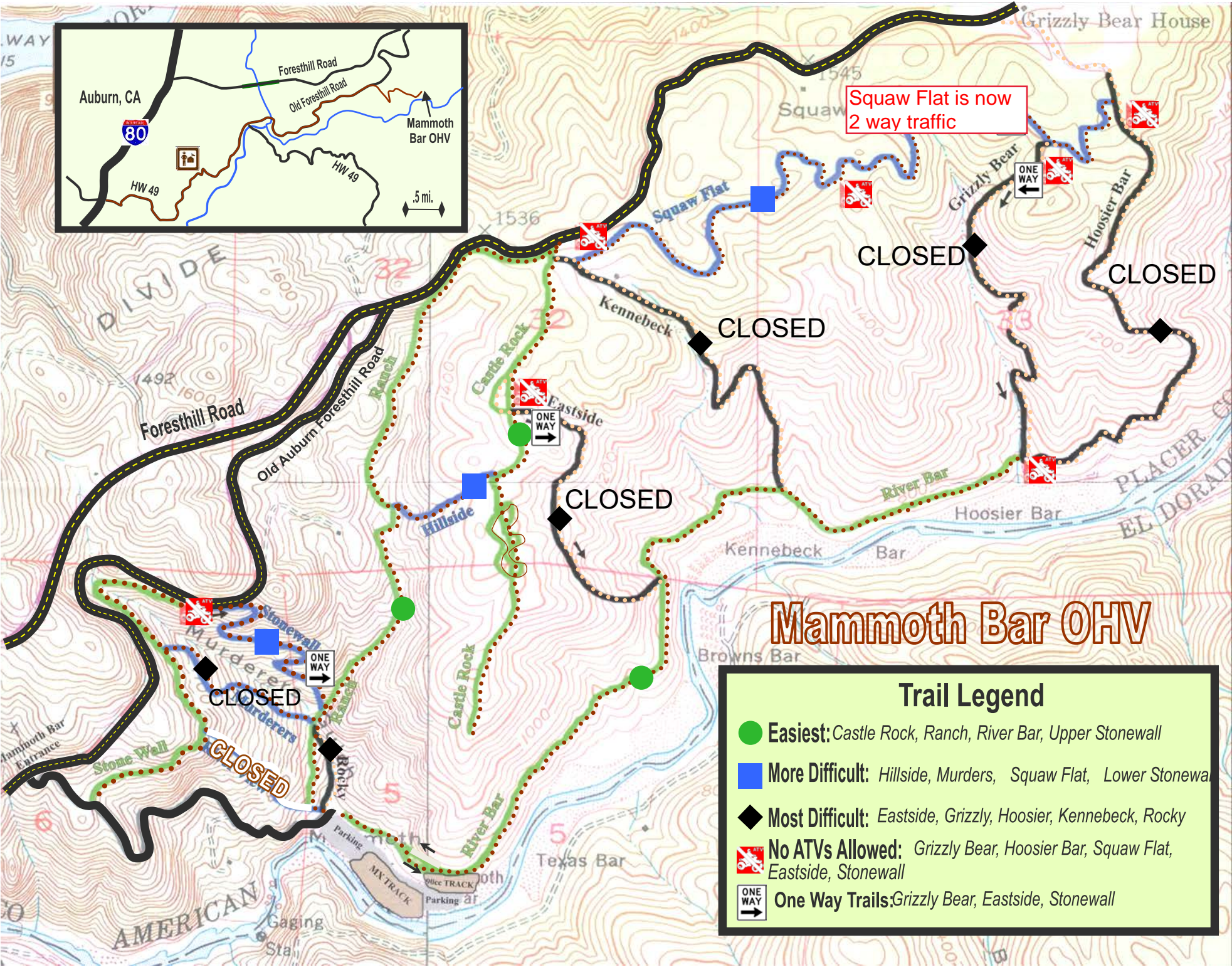
October 1st - March 31st
