Mount Diablo State Park Posted Order- Castle Rock

- 1. In order to preserve and protect Sensitive Peregrine Falcon nesting habitat, the area in Mount Diablo State Park known as Castle Rock is closed to all pedestrians, equine, bicycles or any other mode of transportation, annually from February 1, through July 31 of the same year. The Castle Rock closure area is defined as park lands East of Stage Fire Road, North of the Sunset Trail, West of Falcon Fire Road, and South of the park boundary. A map of this closure area is attached and posted at all Posting locations and in the closure area.
- 2. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private, contractual, residential or property rights.
- 3. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Diablo Range District Superintendent, 15751 Tesla Road, Livermore, California 94550.
- 4. Nothing herein shall be construed to be in derogation of other provisions of law.
