DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S POSTED ORDER No. 007-25-680-680

**Diablo Range District Units  
Camping Time Limits**

1. Effective immediately and pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14 Section 4455-Camping Time Limits, the maximum occupancy limit at **Benicia State Recreation Area, Brannan Island State Recreation Area, Carnegie State Vehicular Recreation Area, Fremont Peak State Park, Henry W. Coe State Park, Hollister Hills State Vehicular Recreation Area, and Mount Diablo State Park**, is thirty (30) days in any calendar year. Camping refers to campsite occupancy by the same person(s), equipment, and/or vehicle(s).
2. Effective immediately and pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14 Section 4455-Camping Time Limits, the seasonal stay limit at **Brannan Island State Recreation Area, Carnegie State Vehicular Recreation Area, Fremont Peak State Park, Henry W. Coe State Park, Hollister Hills State Vehicular Recreation Area, and Mount Diablo State Park** is fifteen (15) consecutive days. When a maximum consecutive stay has occurred, the person(s), equipment, and vehicle(s) must vacate the campground for a period of 48 hours before returning for another stay.
3. Effective immediately and pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14 Section 4457-One-Night Camping in Day Use Areas, "Enroute Camping" is allowed at designated sites within the **Benicia State Recreation Area**. Authorized occupation of the site is for only one night from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. daily. Persons occupying the site for such camping shall vacate the campground by 9:00 a.m. the following morning and shall vacate for a period of 48 hours before returning for another stay.
4. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Diablo Range District Superintendent, 15751 Tesla Road, Livermore California 94550.
5. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private, contractual, and residential or property rights.
6. Nothing herein shall be construed to be in derogation of other provisions of law.
