DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S POSTED ORDER No. 037-25-680-411

San Juan Bautista State Historic Park Museum and Collection Security

1. No person shall enter any museum exhibit room or interpretive exhibit except as authorized by the Department. When on guided tour, all visitors shall remain with the designated guide. No person shall depart from the route of tour as designated by the guide or stray without permission of such guide or his/her superiors into areas prohibited to visitors which are so marked.
2. No person other than an officer or employee of the Department in the course of duty shall touch, handle, or move any museum object or exhibit.
3. No natural or cultural history object/specimen may be moved, relocated, or collected by anyone except as authorized by the Department.
4. No person shall possess, carry, or consume food or beverage within any exhibit or interpretive building except as authorized by the Department.
5. No person shall use photographic, video, or filming equipment when informed by staff or a posted notice that this use is prohibited. No photography, videotaping, or filming is to interfere with scheduled tours, and the time limits allotted them. No photographer/videographer/filmer is to leave the tour route, use tripods, or set any equipment down on any surface without special permission from the Department.
6. Juveniles, elementary (K-6) grade students, teachers, and chaperones will comply with all rules and directions given or sent to them by the park staff.
7. Except as authorized by the Department, no person or group shall enter a museum facility when notified by staff or posted at the museum entrance that the facility is currently occupied by the maximum number of persons established as the carrying capacity.
8. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private, contractual, and residential or property rights.
9. Exceptions to this order may only be granted by a DPR-approved Special Event Permit or Film Permit or in writing by the Diablo Range District Superintendent, 15751 Tesla Road, Livermore California 94550.
10. Nothing herein shall be construed to be in derogation of other provisions of law.
