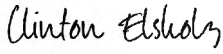

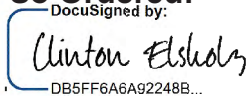

DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S POSTED ORDER No. 001-26-680-412

**Fremont Peak State Park**  
**Fremont Peak State Park - Closure**

1. For public safety, all lands and facilities that comprise to make up Fremont Peak State Park are closed to public use, entry and occupancy. This includes the area around the Observatory.
2. The following conditions shall remain in effect during the term of the closure:
  - a. Closure remains in effect until management decides it is safe for visitor use.
  - b. During the period of closure, all traffic, other than emergency, lessee or Department authorized vehicles, is prohibited.
3. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Diablo Range District Superintendent, 15751 Tesla Road, Livermore, California 94550.
4. Nothing herein shall affect any existing concession contract, private contract or property rights.
5. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
