During the Cold War, a critical defensive weapon, which listened for Soviet submarines, was located in Big Sur, hidden in plain sight. The Point Sur Naval Facility was one of only 27 SOSUS (SOund SURveillance System) sites worldwide. Most are now gone. Historic Point Sur NAVFAC, a California State Historic Park, is the only complete, stand-alone SOSUS site on the West Coast.

On Sunday, August 31, 2025, the Pt. Sur Naval Facility will host an Open House. Visitors will be able to explore the old Cold War base on their own. A guide book will be provided and docents will be scattered around the base to answer questions and to explain the secrets of the base. Hear about spies and turncoats and secret undersea operations.
