

The Program

Week-long classes are held at the beautiful Pacific House and Memory Garden which is a 1840s adobe building and a heritage garden. The property is a State Historic Park site.

State Park staff, Meghan Braillard and Sam Koehler, will instruct students through hands-on activities and includes tours of Monterey's historical sites and buildings, period games and

toys, crafts, food, songs and dances, and Spanish vocabulary.

- The week culminates in a "Fandango" where students share what they have learned with family members and take home the treasures they have made.
- Students are also provided with historic reproduction ٠ clothing to wear for their week of time travel.

Summer History Day Program:
