NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE AREA  
SANTA SUSANNA STATE HISTORIC PARK

1. In order to maintain visitor safety and protect the resource, Santa Susana Pass State Historic Park is hereby designated as a no alcoholic beverage area. This order is all inclusive of the park unit and includes day use areas, parking areas and undeveloped portions of the trailhead with the following exception:
  - Authorized events.
2. The period of closure shall be indefinite.
3. The District Superintendent, or his designee, may grant exemptions to this order as determined to be necessary for the proper administration of the park, and to protect the safety and welfare of its visitors, employees and resources. All exemptions, except for emergency personnel, must be obtained in writing. Requests for exemptions may be made by contacting the District Superintendent, Angeles District, 1925 Las Virgenes Road, Calabasas, California 91302.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law, existing contracts or property rights previously granted.
5. This Order has been posted pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 4301 (i).
