District Superintendent Order No. 915-22-034

Posted Order – Point Dume Natural Preserve – Prohibited Areas

1. Persons are restricted to designated trails, walkways, overlooks and beaches at Point Dume Natural Preserve. Designated trails, walkways, overlooks or beaches are only those facilities constructed, maintained and/or delineated by the Department. All other areas of Point Dume Natural Preserve are declared prohibited areas.
2. This order shall remain in effect immediately.
3. The District Superintendent, or his designee, may grant exemptions to this order as determined necessary for the proper administration of the park, and to protect the safety and welfare of its visitors, employees, wildlife, and resources. All exemptions, except for emergency personnel, must be obtained in writing. Requests for exemptions may be made by contacting the District Superintendent, Angeles District, 1925 Las Virgenes Road, Calabasas, CA 91302.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of any existing provisions of law, private, contractual, residential or property rights.
5. This order has been posted pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 4301(i).
