District Superintendent Order No. 915-25-003

Posted Order - Topanga State Park Unauthorized Trail Use Closure

- 1. Effective immediately, all users of backcountry trails of Topanga State Park are hereby directed to only use authorized (marked and mapped) trails and are prohibited from using unauthorized trails (unmarked and/or unmapped or signs listing closure.)
- 2. These restrictions apply to all park visitors on foot, on bike, and/or on horseback.
- 3. These restrictions will be in effect indefinitely.
- 4. Violators are subject to ejections, citation, and/or arrest.
- 5. Only those persons authorized by the District Superintendent may enter or remain in these areas in the performance of their official duties.
- 6. These restrictions are in effect to provide for the safety of visitors and rehabilitation of the fragile natural resources.
- 7. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Angeles District Superintendent, 1925 Las Virgenes Road, Calabasas, Ca 91302.
- 8. Nothing herein contained shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law
