COYOTE CANYON

1. The following land facilities of Anza-Borrego Desert State Park are hereby closed to all public use and occupancy from October 1, 2017 until this order is lifted by direction of the Colorado Desert District Superintendent. No access by foot, horseback or vehicle is allowed.

Coyote Canyon from Lower Willows to Middle Willows in San Diego County

2. Exceptions to this closing may only be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Colorado Desert District,
200 Palm Canyon Drive, Borrego Springs, CA 92004-5005
3. Nothing herein shall affect any existing contracts or property rights.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions by law.
