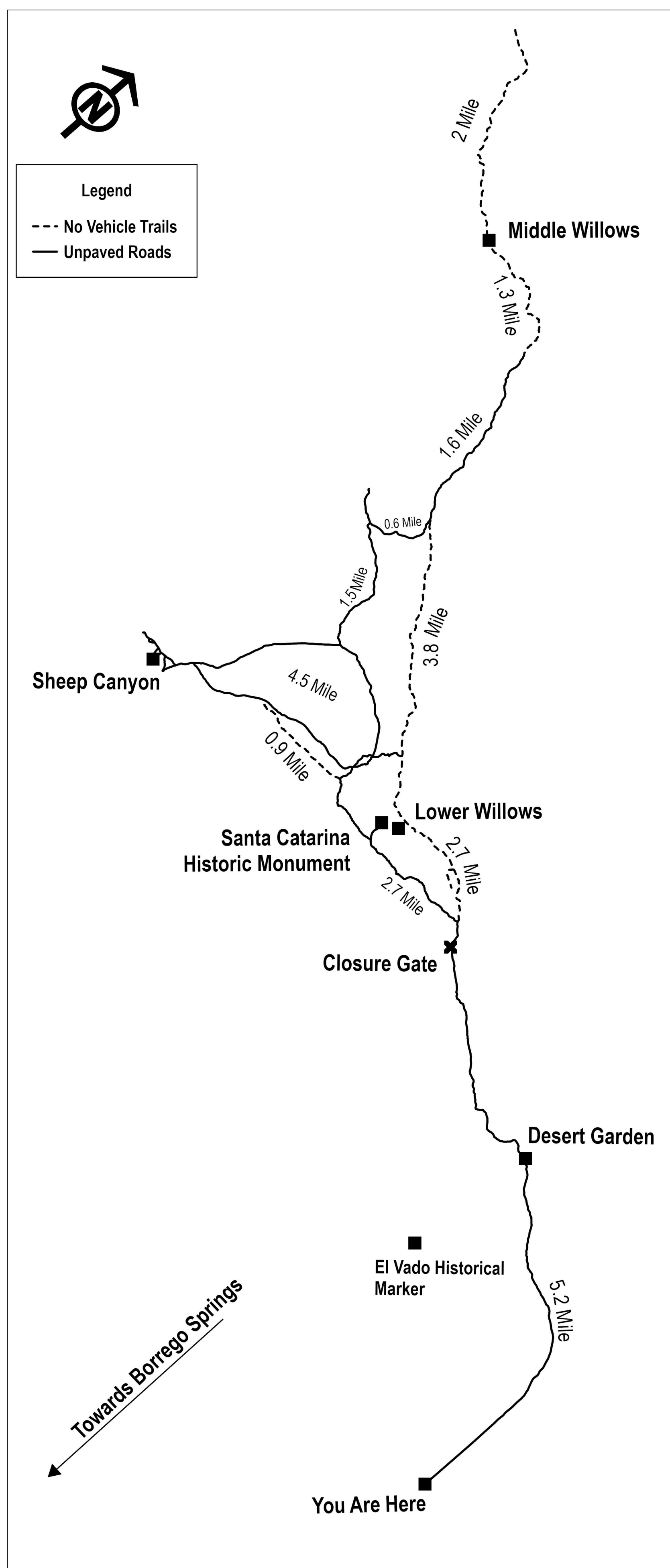


ROAD CLOSURE

Coyote Canyon Road Closed 5.2 Miles Ahead at 3rd Crossing.



ATTENTION: PARKING IS LIMITED AT CLOSURE GATE

On August 19, 2023, Tropical Storm Hilary impacted Coyote Canyon in Anza Borrego Desert State Park diverting Coyote Creek onto Coyote Canyon Dirt Road resulting in a road closure at Lower Willows / third crossing gate to all vehicle traffic.

10.7 miles of Coyote Canyon Dirt Road is closed to vehicle traffic from Lower Willows to Middle Willows, but remains accessible to walk in camping, hikers, cyclists, and equestrians.

State Parks is working to resolve the road closure that provides a safe recreational opportunity for the public while protecting sensitive resources.
