



JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

PICACHO STATE RECREATION AREA

If you love working outdoors or are interested in starting a career in Parks this job may be for you!

Picacho State Recreation Area has immediate openings for a Maintenance Aide and a Visitor Services Park Aide. The reporting location is Picacho State Recreation Area on the Lower Colorado River. This is a remote location and reliable transportation is a must. Housing may be available. Park Aides are often the first person the public encounters when entering a State Park. You must be prepared to represent State Parks in a positive way. Applicants must be willing to purchase and wear a uniform and conform to minimal grooming standards.

Park Maintenance Aides are responsible for housekeeping, keeping grounds neat and orderly and tasks as they apply to buildings, grounds, structures and other facilities within the unit. They will maintain basic records and follow established maintenance standards. Collecting visitor fees in the absence of the Visitor Services Aide may be required. The Maintenance Aide position will work through the summer so this applicant must be prepared to work safely outdoors in extreme weather conditions. Starting wage is \$10.28 per hour.

Visitor Services Park Aides staff the campground entrance, interact with the public, collect fees, register campers, conduct camp checks, explain rules and regulations, and answer a wide variety of questions from the public. Must be able to handle money, account for fees and accurately complete basic forms. Light housekeeping may be required in the absence of the Park Maintenance Aide. Starting wage is \$10.43 per hour.

Applicants must possess the ability to read, write and speak English at a level required for successful job performance; demonstrate ability to follow directions; compute simple mathematical calculations; learn work procedures and park rules and regulations; perform various manual tasks; interact successfully with the public and address their concerns; and possess the ability to work cooperatively and effectively with park staff and volunteers. Applicants must possess a valid driver license. Training is provided. Applicants must be willing to work day shift or swing shift, weekends and holidays. A 30-40 hour work week is normal.

Applicants must be able to travel to Picacho SRA for their in-person interview. Phone interviews are available for those living over 100 miles away. Applications accepted until positions are filled.
