Prohibition of Alcoholic Beverages Lake Perris SRA

March 8, 2021 Inland Empire District

DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENTS ORDER NO. 952-21-004

Supersedes Posted Order 952-19-004, 950-05-001

- The consumption of alcoholic beverages is hereby prohibited within the Day Use areas of Lake Perris State Recreation Area, with the exception of boaters on the lake and marina slip holders while docked and registered in slips.
- 2. Consumption will include dominion or control of an open container. Open containers are defined according to the California Vehicle Code as: any bottle, can, or other receptacle containing any alcoholic beverage, which has been opened, or seal broken, or the content of which have been partially removed.
- 3. The District Superintendent, or designee, may grant exemptions to this order as determined necessary for the proper administration of the park, and to protect the safety and welfare of its visitors, employees, wildlife and resources. All Exemptions, except for emergency personnel, must be obtained in writing. Requests for exemptions may be made by contacting the District Superintendent, Inland Empire District, 17801 Lake Perris Dr., Perris, California 92571.
- 4. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contract or property rights.
- 5. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law.
