SCHOOL PROGRAM INFORMATION

With prior arrangements, all school programs are **FREE!**

Lake Perris State Recreation Area school tours are typically 1.5 hours of interactive programming. Programs are available on Thursdays and Fridays from 9:00a.m. until 2:00p.m. Tours are available March through November.

Program Description: The Lake Perris Regional Indian Museum school tours provide a comprehensive interpretation of California Indian history and culture throughout the desert region. Students enjoy the opportunity to take an interpreter or docent led tour through the museum, view a film and participate in a variety of indigenous cultural activities (i.e.: games, storytelling, and arts and crafts). In addition, we offer programs that provide enrichment in Earth / Life / Physical Sciences.



As of September 2017, groups can move, play, and learn using the [Agents of Discovery](#) application. With the use of tablets or mobile devices classes will have the option to go on an enhanced nature walk in the park. Please ask for more information.

In addition, classes are invited to extend their visit by having a picnic lunch in the park (lunches are not provided). Classes are also invited to participate in self-guided park activities.

Please call for reservations and email or fax the attached form at least 3 weeks prior to your requested field trip. If you have any questions or special needs please contact the museum at the number listed above.
