Explore early San Diego with your class. Students will gain an understanding of the early history of California; from before the Spanish arrival, the Mexican Period, the Mexican-American War, the Gold Rush, and finally the early American frontier town that eventually became Old Town San Diego.



Receive an overview of California history (1760s–1870s) from our knowledgeable park staff. These living history tours include participation and interaction with our staff, historic buildings, and artifacts. We aim to give students a hands-on, first person appreciation for people, events, and material culture in order to connect them with California's past. The program is designed to engage students and assist teachers by offering activities that enhance and enrich the history lessons that they learn in the classroom. Old Town San Diego State Historic Park's tours are also aligned with current state curriculum standards.
