Fire Restrictions-Cuyamaca Rancho State Park

DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S ORDER NUMBER:

940-20-013

In accordance with provisions of California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 4326, for the protection of the health and safety of persons, property, and resources of the lands and facilities of Cuyamaca Rancho State Park, I hereby declare the following: Fire Ban / Restrictions during Extreme Heat / Fire Danger Warnings / Limited Firefighting Resources – Cuyamaca Rancho State Park.

1. As a result of extreme fire danger and limited firefighting resources, the following fire restrictions are in effect during periods of Extreme Heat / Fire Danger Warnings / Limited Resources:

The backcountry areas of Cuyamaca Rancho State Park including Arroyo Seco Trail Camp and Granite Springs Trail Camp open fires, including campfires and barbecues are prohibited. Portable propane or gas stoves are permitted for cooking only within designated campsites and day use areas.

Open fires, including campfires and barbecues are prohibited at Paso Picacho Campground and at Green Valley Campground. Portable propane or gas stoves are permitted for cooking only within designated campsites.

Fireworks are prohibited.

Smoking is only permitted within designated areas of developed facilities or vehicles.

2. Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the District Superintendent, Colorado Desert District, 200 Palm Canyon Drive, Borrego Springs CA 92004-5005
3. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private contracts or property rights.
4. Nothing herein shall be construed in derogation of other provisions by law.
