## Posted Order – Red Flag Closure

All riding and hiking trails, fire roads, and undeveloped portions of the Angeles District State Parks shall be closed to public use (prohibited areas) during periods of “Red Flag Warning” as defined by the National Fire Danger Rating System.

- Undeveloped portions of the Angeles District are defined as:
  - All areas beyond vehicle accessible designated campgrounds
  - All areas beyond designated public day use areas
  - All areas beyond designated public parking areas
- Units administered by the Angeles District and affected by this order are: Will Rogers and Santa Susana Pass State Historic Parks, Topanga, Malibu Creek/Tapia, Leo Carrillo, and Point Mugu State Parks.

These restrictions are in effect immediately for the protection of the health and safety of all persons and the protection of property and resources in the areas described above.

Exceptions to this order may only be granted in writing by the Angeles District Superintendent, 1925 Las Virgenes Road, Calabasas, Ca 91302.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law
