Second Annual Acorn Festival at Malibu Creek State Park on Saturday, September 28

On Saturday, September 28, the second annual Acorn Festival will be held at Malibu Creek State Park from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. The Malibu Creek Docents are sponsoring this harvest-time festival in the park's beautiful chaparral and oak woodlands. The park is located four miles south of Highway 101 off the Las Virgenes/Malibu Canyon Road exit and eight miles north of Pacific Coast Highway via Malibu Canyon Road. The park address is 1925 Las Virgenes Road in Calabasas.

The festival will include fun, arts and crafts for children; crafts for sale; Native American dancers; and live Blue Grass music and other entertainment. There will be a native wildlife exhibit by the Wildlife Waystation and a show by the Nature of Wildworks, plus booths highlighting the natural and cultural history of Malibu Creek State Park and information on the environment, nature, and parklands.

Parking is \$2 (\$1 for seniors) – but entrance to the event is FREE. Visitors are advised to wear sunscreen, a hat, and bring drinking water.
