Ms. Williams has been working for the department in a variety of capacities over 14 years, most recently working as State Park Superintendent II for the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle and Recreation Division. Prior to her appointment to Angel Island she served as the Department's Statewide Recruitment Manager in Sacramento. Her training and experience includes supervision of many popular State Parks and campgrounds located on the Central Coast. One of two African American female State Park Rangers, she has dedicated her career to preserving California's extraordinary cultural and natural resources. Her successes are attributed to understanding diverse points of view and articulating the synthesis of these views to accomplish State Parks goals.

Ms. Williams will be coordinating the progress of the Immigration Station project, which is in the middle of a \$15 million restoration.
