5 MPH Speed Limit at Folsom Rescinded

FOLSOM – The 5 MPH Speed Limit at Folsom Lake has been rescinded. The temporary speed limit has been in place since August 31st due to extremely low lake levels. With the recent rains and warm weather, the lake level has increased to approximately 400 feet in elevation, about 28 feet higher than its lowest level of 371.85 feet on the 2nd of January.

“Visitors are welcome to come out and enjoy the lake,” said Park Superintendent Michael Gross of California State Parks. “We just want to make sure they are aware with the rising lake levels to exercise extreme caution for unmarked hazards.”

Boaters can use boat ramps at either Granite Bay or Browns Ravine. All other ramps are currently closed until the lake level increases.
