NEW IMPROVEMENTS FOR FOLSOM POINT BOAT LAUNCH FACILITY AT FOLSOM LAKE STATE RECREATION AREA

New improvements are nearing completion at the Folsom Point Launch Ramp Facility of Folsom Lake State Recreation Area. May 15th through May 17th the Folsom Point Boat Launch and Launch Ramp Parking Lot will be closed to public use while the area is being resurfaced. The area will be closed again May 29th and May 30th for roadway and parking lot striping. All other day use facilities will be open and available for public use during this closure.

The boat launch facility renovation project that started last fall with funding provided by the California Department of Boating and Waterways will be completed by June 1st. The purpose of the project was to reconfigure the parking lot to improve flow and function, bring the ADA accessible parking to current standards, provide ship shape lanes for easier ingress and egress and to add retaining walls for slope stabilization around the parking lot. Park Superintendent Rich Preston stated, "We hope our visitors can excuse this inconvenience for a few days while these great improvements are being completed".

Alternate launch facilities for Folsom Lake are available at Brown's Ravine and Granite Bay.
