**Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Commission Meeting and  
Attendance at the 45<sup>th</sup> Hangtown Motocross Classic

On Friday, May 17, 2013, the California State Parks Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Commission will hold a public meeting at the Lake Natoma Inn, 702 Gold Lake Drive, Folsom, California. The Commission will receive updates on legislation, the State Parks' 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, Oceano Dunes/PMRP, and the Hangtown Motocross Classic event held at Prairie City State Vehicular Recreation Area (SVRA).

The public is also invited to join the OHMVR Commission on Saturday, May 18, 2013, at the 45<sup>th</sup> Hangtown Motocross Classic, Prairie City SVRA, 13300 White Rock Road, Rancho Cordova, California.

The OHMVR Commission consists of nine members appointed by the Governor, Senate Committee on Rules, and the Speaker of the Assembly. The Commissioners are responsible for hearing the concerns and issues of the public related to off-highway vehicle recreation in California and for providing input and recommendations for improving the California State Parks OHMVR Program.

Obtaining public input is an important purpose of the meeting. The public may present oral statements at the Commission meeting at the appropriate time.
