## Office of Historic Preservation Seeks Public Comment on Proposed Historic Rehabilitation Tax Credit Regulations

*SACRAMENTO, Calif.*— The California Office of Historic Preservation (OHP) seeks public comment on proposed regulations to provide OHP the authority and discretion to regulate the State Historic Rehabilitation Tax Credit Program in conjunction with the California Tax Credit Allocation Committee. The public review period is now open until June 20, 2023.

The State Historic Rehabilitation Tax Credit Program provides a 20% California tax credit to property owners that rehabilitate their historical buildings. When property owners improve buildings by complying with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation, California's historic buildings maintain their historical significance and better interpret our State's history. The tax credit encourages repair and sensitive replacement of historical elements on building(s) instead of replacement with modern materials.

The OHP administers federal and state mandated historic preservation programs to further the identification, evaluation, registration, and protection of California's irreplaceable resources, and promotes the care, maintenance, relevance and reuse of California's historic properties.
