California State Parks Seeks Public Input Regarding Blue Wing Inn Concession

SONOMA — California State Parks seeks public input on the future of the concession located within [Sonoma State Historic Park](#) (SHP) inside the building known as the Blue Wing Inn. A public meeting will be held on **Thursday, Oct. 24, at 6 p.m.** at Sonoma SHP located at 114 E Spain St., Sonoma, CA 95476.

Sonoma SHP is a scattering of historical sites consisting of six midtown locations near Sonoma's Plaza. Within the park boundaries are numerous historic buildings, including the Blue Wing Inn, a circa-1830 two-story historic adobe building located on the edge of the Sonoma Plaza which offers a variety of restaurants, shops, and more.

To better serve visitors at Sonoma SHP, State Parks will issue a Request for Proposals for a new concession contract through a competitive bid process. Input from the public meeting will aid officials in planning the concession's future facilities and operations.
