Posted Order – Malibu Pier Closure

In the interest of public safety:

1. The Malibu Pier is closed to public access beyond the second white gate (see attached map).
2. Other portions of the Malibu Pier may be closed to public access during high surf advisories as predicted by the National Weather Service.
3. This order shall remain in effect indefinitely.

The District Superintendent, or designee, may grant exceptions to this order as determined necessary for the proper administration of the park, and to protect the safety and welfare of its visitors, employees, wildlife, and resources. All exceptions, except for emergency personnel, must be granted in writing by the Angeles District Superintendent, 1925 Las Virgenes Road, Calabasas, CA 91302.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed in derogation of other provisions of law
