PROJECT TITLE: Shop Retaining Wall and Trailer Parking Pad

LOCATION: Tahoe State Recreation Area

COUNTY: Placer

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Construct a retaining wall, one employee trailer pad and an armored drip line at the Maintenance Shop and former Hillside Campground Areas at Tahoe State Recreation Area (TSRA) to upgrade the facility and to provide building security. Work will:

- To Construct Retaining Wall Behind the Maintenance Shop and Install Drip Line:
 - Excavate a trench approximately 3" deep x 5' wide and 50' long between the maintenance shop and proposed retaining wall location for drip line; fill with 3/4" - 1 1/2" drain rock.
 - Excavate ten (10) 2' x 2' x 3' deep holes parallel to and five feet away from the maintenance shop; set one 6" x 6" post in each hole; fill with concrete to secure.
 - Use bolts to attach a 2" x 12" redwood planks to 6" x 6" posts to construct a 50' long x 3' high redwood retaining wall.
- To Install New Trailer Parking Pad in the former Hillside Campground Area:
 - Remove dilapidated 29' x 9' comfort station and 38' L X 10' W concrete foundation and surrounding degraded asphalt; haul debris to local disposal agency.
 - Excavate to level an approximately 30' L x 12' W area, cover with compacted class II road base and pave with 1.5" of asphalt.
 - Install utility pedestal to support infrastructure for two trailer pads (present construction and future construction); tie into existing water, sewer and power utilities adjacent to trailer pad for employee use.

Follow Best Management Practices; place straw wattles around the work area; store equipment on pavement at the TSRA maintenance shop.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of the repair or minor alteration of existing public facilities involving negligible expansion of use beyond current levels; construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities and minor public alterations in the condition of land and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry purposes; included as "mobile home pads with utility connections" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities, in accordance with CCRS15300.4.
