PROJECT TITLE: Needle Rock Roof and Siding Shingle Replacement

LOCATION: Sinkyone Wilderness State Park COUNTY: Mendocino

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Replace roof and siding shingles in-kind on the historic Needle Rock Visitor Center in Sinkyone Wilderness State Park to protect the structure and support its maintenance and continued use. Work will:

- Remove and dispose of existing roofing and siding shingles and flashing;
- Remove and replace any roof or siding sheathing showing signs of degradation;
- Install new flashing at all plumbing and vent openings, roof perimeter and roof to wall locations;
- Install felt underlayment atop roof and siding sheathing; and
- Install fire-rated cedar wood shingles that match the size and shape of removed shingles.


