PROJECT TITLE: Install Cultural Resource Panels

LOCATION: Anderson Marsh State Historic Park **COUNTY:** Lake

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install two (2) Cultural Resource Interpretive Panels at Anderson Marsh State Historic Park to enhance the interpretive experience of park visitors. At Cache Creek Trail, north of the Ranch House and at White Bridge Road at the North Flat, work will:

- Excavate one (1) hole 24" deep x 12" diameter at each location;
- Set one (1) 3"x3" steel post in each excavated hole and fill with concrete;
- Mount an 18"x32" panel at a 45° angle on the steel post;

At the Cache Creek Trail site, place and compact a 30"x48" gravel pad, atop existing ground surface to accommodate ADA access.
