**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Restore approximately 22 acres of dune habitat and install fencing at Fort Ord Dunes State Park to enhance and restore habitat for native and threatened and endangered plants and animals.

Work will:

- hand pull or spray herbicide on non-native iceplant to eradicate;
- plant seedlings grown from native plant seeds collected in the area, and
- install approximately 1500' of post and cable fencing to protect the area from foot traffic.
