**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT**: Install steel gates and lodge pole fencing at specific locations along the Mammoth Bar OHV trail system within Auburn State Recreation Area to allow for the closure of individual trails for public safety and resource protection. Work will:

- Excavate forty-five (45) postholes 36" deep x 24" in diameter;
- Install fifteen (15), tubular steel gates and secure posts in postholes with concrete;
- Excavate ninety-five (95) postholes 30" deep x 18" in diameter; and
- Install 6" peeler core posts to support 619 linear feet of lodge pole fencing.
