PROJECT TITLE: Backcountry Gate Removal

LOCATION: Big Basin Redwoods State Park COUNTY: Santa Cruz

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Remove unnecessary fire road gates to improve park aesthetic, visitor experience, and emergency responder access, in the backcountry of Big Basin Redwoods State Park. Some gates are still in usable order, two (2) of which will be reused on Tan Bark Loop between Big Basin Redwoods State Park and sub-unit Little Basin. Work Will:

- Excavate sixteen (16) post holes 1.5'x3' to remove eight (8) backcountry gates;
- Excavate four (4) post holes 1.5'x5' on Tan Bark Loop;
- Pour concrete and secure four (4) gate posts; and
- Install two (2) reused gates.
