DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Project will remove a dilapidated deck and old concrete tub from Gilroy Hot Springs soaking area, with the intent to replace in the future. The deck is a modern structure with no significant historical or cultural value. Park staff and volunteers will use hand tools to disassemble material for removal, load debris into two pickup trucks with 6- by 8-foot trailers, and haul offsite for disposal.
