PROJECT TITLE: Park Entrance and Land Acknowledgement Signs

LOCATION: Azalea State Natural Reserve, Fort Humboldt State Historic Park
Little River State Beach

COUNTY: Humboldt

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The project proposes to install or replace park entrance signs in Azalea State Natural Reserve, Fort Humboldt State Historic Park and Little River State Beach to inform visitors of the names of the people whose land the park is built on. Per sign, work will use hand tools or a small gas-powered auger to excavate two (2) 12-in. dia. by 48-in. deep holes approximately 96-inches apart. There will be one (1) sign at Azalea State Natural Reserve, two (2) signs installed at Little River State Beach, and two (2) signs installed at Fort Humboldt State Historic Park. Where reasonable, signs will be installed in the locations as existing signs, to minimize ground disturbance.

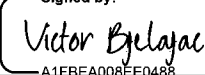

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consist of the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond current levels; replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced; construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures, and is included as "Construction or installation of park facilities, such as signs" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities in accordance with CCR § 15300.4; and minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees.
