DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Perform regular and routine maintenance on the Yogurt Canyon crossing of Monument Road in Border Field State Park to improve visitor services. No excavation is required. Road base will be contained entirely on existing road alignment and will not encroach on adjacent natural areas. No native vegetation will be impacted; some invasive plants may be removed.
